Philanthropy and Annual Giving at Ascension



As an independent school, Ascension operates solely on tuition and gift income. Participation in Annual Giving signals that our school community has confidence in the mission of the school. These gifts support the people and programs that make Ascension special—including small class size, vital academic programming, arts and athletics, and a talented faculty in a Christian environment.



Every member of the Ascension school community is asked every year to support the Annual Giving. To ensure this much-needed support, we will ask for participation to Annual Giving *first* to support annual budgetary program needs and then welcome additional gifts as possible to benefit capital needs, endowment and special projects.

The school will make an appeal to you early in the school year asking for your support of Annual Giving. We ask that you consider making a gift or pledge of support in the fall. Pledging in the fall may provide the opportunity to spread out the pledge payments over a longer period of time. We ask that pledges be paid by June 30 of each year and are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.



Unrestricted gifts have the most impact because they allow the school to use the gifts to support the areas of greatest need. However, many donors choose to designate their gifts to a specific fund.
